25: Continue to give thanks & pray for our Sunday school teachers – children to adult – who prepare & lead lessons weekly. Let them know their labor is not in vain.

26: The words of Paul to the church in Philippi are true for us today: do not be anxious about anything...put our requests to God in prayer. **Philippians 4:6-7**

27: As you pray, ask God to help you intercede for others in need of prayer. Create a list of people who need your daily prayers. Be courageous & let them know you are praying for them. **Ephesians 6:18**

28: Lean on, put your trust in the Lord. Seek the Lord in prayer when you have decisions to make and discern the path He has set before you. **Proverbs 3:5-6**

29: Continue to pray for those on our prayer lists. Ask God to “help you carry their burdens” for them.

Galatians 6:2

30: As we approach 2020, pray that we continue to seek the Lord’s plans for our church to prosper & bring hope to our world. **Jeremiah 29:11-13**

September Prayer Guide 2019



September 1: As we begin a new month, commit to praying for our church daily. Pray that we walk in a manner “worthy of the Lord.” **Colossians 1:9-10**

2: Seek opportunities to grow in your faith through small groups, prayer teams, Sunday school or other gatherings at church. **Colossians 3:16**

3: Take time to ask the Lord “to teach us how to pray just as John taught his disciples.” Trust in God’s faithfulness as you pray. **Luke 11:1**

4: Begin today with expectation as you see what God is doing in your life. Pray that you will see “God at work” throughout your day. **Psalms 5:1-3**

5: Remember that God has established the church as a sanctuary. Pray for our church & discern how God may be calling you to serve in the church. **1 Kings 9:3**

6: Give thanks to God for those in your midst – past & present - who have shaped you into the person you are today. Believe God will put others in your path as you continue your faith journey. **James 1:17**

7: Please pray for those in our midst who provide care to others, especially the sick & aging. **Deuteronomy 14:29**

8: Continue to pray for the leaders & girls involved in Mary’s Maidens. Ask God to bless their lives & those they help with their many projects. **Proverbs 22:6**

9: Pray for our church staff, especially Patricia, Alston, and Taylor as they bring hope & healing through Christ to each of us. **Acts 20:28**

10: Ask God to help you find time for private prayer so your faith is strengthened & renewed. **Matthew 6:6-8**

11: Often we take for granted “our glorious riches” that Christ has given us. Pray for your heart to be enlightened with hope & peace only Christ brings. **Ephesians 1:18**

12: Jesus teaches us “to love our enemies” so name them then pray for them. See how God can turn our enemies into friends. **Luke 6:27-31**

13: Ask God to help our church be a beacon of faith, hope, grace & generosity to our community and into the world. **Matthew 28:19**

14: Give thanks for our trustees who work to preserve our facilities & ensure we make necessary improvements. **1 Chronicles 23:28-32**

15: Be in prayer for our youth & those who have committed to pray for them this school year through “Praying Across Generations.” **Deuteronomy 31:6**

16: Please pray for our music ministry as we are in a period of transition. Pray that our team can work together to glorify you through song. **Psalms 51:15**

17: Seek an opportunity today to share your faith with someone. Pray for the Spirit to help you overcome your fears so you can speak boldly for Christ. **Philemon 1:6**

18: Pray for healing & restoration in your life, our church & world. Trust God to heal the brokenness in our lives. **2 Chronicles 7:14**

19: Seek to discern how you can be “a shepherd after God’s own heart who will lead with knowledge & understanding.” **Jeremiah 3:15**

20: Continue to pray for our Neighborhood Sunday Dinner on the 22nd. May it be a time of food, fellowship & hope among all who participate. **Luke 10:38-42**

21: Pray for God to help us not talk about everything that irritates us for gossip keeps our anger alive. Seek silence & prayer instead. **Proverbs 26:20**
