\*LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT CANDLE (Focus: Isaiah 40:1-11)

Reader: We light the second candle of Advent as we seek God's peace. (With the first candle already burning, a member lights the second candle.)

Reader: Isaiah announced God's coming to a people exiled in a broken and parched wilderness. He declared that God's redemption would make a highway in the desert and change the rough places into plain. God would come as a shepherd—feeding, leading, and cradling the weary flock.

Reader: We seek God's redemptive love and grace that will transform us and bring us the inner peace we seek.

Congregational Prayer: Saving God, look upon your world and heal your land and your people. Prepare us to be changed more and more into the likeness of Christ. This Advent fill us with your peace and teach us to be tender and just, as you are. Amen.
