Programs are evaluated and earn ratings from A (the best) to C (better than average). Simply having an ABC Quality rating means a program exceeds expectations for the care they provide to children. Every ABC Quality program must be current on first aid/CPR, complete 15 hours of pre-service training or complete Early Child Development 101 and confirm adherence to the ABC Quality Code of Ethics.
