Our Circle is made up of a great group of warm, welcoming women who really enjoy learning, laughing, and sharing fellowship time together. We meet on the first Tuesday of each month at 10:00am in the John Harper Classroom. We are currently the only Circle at WSUMC that meets in the morning.

Our mission focus for this year is The Killingsworth Home, which is a Christian residential home for women who are emerging from crisis situations and trying to change their lives for the better. It is located here in Columbia, has strong ties to our church, and is sponsored and supported by United Women in Faith, locally and nationally.

At our meetings, we begin with a short devotional shared by one of our members, followed by any business we need to discuss and anything members would like to share with the group. Then we have a lesson shared with us by our wonderful teacher, Rev. Diana Westerkam, for whom our Circle is named.

Diana's lessons are very interesting, inspiring, and thought-provoking. We always learn something new, or are challenged to look at scriptural passages or themes from a different perspective and often in ways we hadn't thought of before. Diana encourages interaction and there is usually plenty of lively discussion around the table during her lessons. We are truly blessed to have Diana as our teacher!
