One of the many mission ministries at WSUMC is our Circle of Welcome. Working in partnership with Lutheran Services Carolinas, we are excited to report that our family of four from Venezuela (via Colombia) is thriving. Thanks to the congregation's generosity, the family is comfortably settled in their apartment. The father is working, and the second grader was thrilled to start school. The mother receives English tutoring from COW members several times a week.

Because of actions at the federal level, refugees are no longer receiving the critical financial support that they relied on during their first few months in America. Because of the great current need, our Circle of Welcome has decided to come alongside another family. We have been matched with a family of four who arrived from Eritrea in January. There is a mom, a dad (who is blind), a five-year-old son, and a two-year-old daughter. Please keep both of these families, as well as all refugees, in your prayers.
