Person 1 Person 2	Driver for Senior Adult Daytrips and/or youth trips: If you like to drive and are able to fit 3 or more people in your vehicle, this is a perfect ministry to be a part of on an as-needed basis.
Person 1 Person 2	Worship Audio/Visual Team: Training is available for all who would like to assist with providing sound and visual projections used in services of worship and/or learn the technology behind our ability to livestream our worship services.
